ERRATA TO MINUTE ORDER NO. 4

STANDING

Minute Order No. 4, which was issued on April 27, 2017, contained citation errors. The last paragraph of said Minute Order No. 4 is corrected to read as follows. (The corrections are set forth in **bold** print.)

Elizabeth Rago lives two blocks from the proposed wind farm and is concerned about health issues and the decline in property value due to the proximity to the wind farm. However, she has not indicated how she will be directly and immediately affected by the approval of the Incidental Take License and the Habitat Conservation Plan, which are the subjects of this contested case. Instead, Rago's environmental concerns are not clearly distinguishable from that of the general public. Thus, Rago is not entitled to be admitted as a party pursuant to Hawai'i Administrative Rules (HAR) § 13-1-31(b)(2). However, Rago has shown a substantial interest in the matter and her participation will assist the Board in its decision-making. Therefore, Elizabeth Rago is admitted as a party pursuant to HAR § 13-1-31(c).
